What is University for Children?



University for Children is a community education project which is open to children aged 7 to 13. 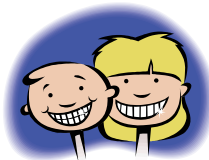


will lead to the award of a prestigious University for Children Certificate. These certificates build up towards University for Children
